- 1. The diversion processing fee of **\$125.00**, is Non-Refundable. You must pay with a check/cashier's check or money order (**NO CASH** accepted).
- 2. Once your evaluation is received, it will then be up to the District Attorney whether or not you are approved for Diversion. Upon approval or denial, your attorney will be contacted by the District Attorney's Office. If approved, an appointment **MUST** be scheduled with Reno County Community Corrections within <u>7 days</u> of your notification of approval. Please advise the Diversion Office of any changes of phone number and/or address while awaiting approval/denial. You must pay the \$120.00 Supervision Fee within <u>14 days</u> of approval.
- 3. Estimated Fees: **(In addition to the \$125.00 application fee)** Supervision fee - \$120 KBI Fees (If applicable) - \$400.00 Drug diversion monitoring fee - \$380.00 Random UA lab confirmation - \$20.00 each
- 4. Upon approval and signing of your Diversion Agreement, you will be on "Diversion" for approximately an 18month period. During that time, you will be required to remain abstinent from Drugs **AND** Alcohol OR any bother mind altering substance; Follow the Recommendations of your supervising officer; Submit to frequent and random UA's; Periodic check-ins with the Diversion Coordinator and/or your supervising officer and any other conditions as directed by the District Attorney or your supervising officer.
- 5. Violation of the agreement and/or terms could result in the revocation of your diversion and the case being referred back to District Court for a trial on stipulated facts.
