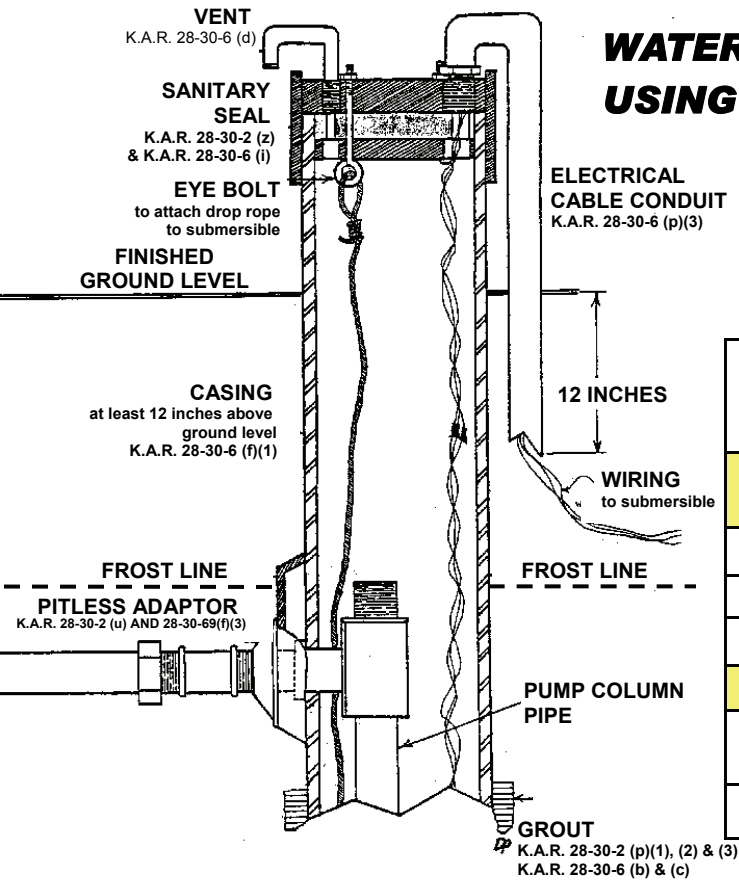


Water Wells: Construction & Reconstruction



WATER WELL COMPLETION DIAGRAM USING SUBMERSIBLE PUMP WITH PITLESS

This table complies with the Reno County Sanitation Code, Chapter 3, Article 3, Section 4, which in turn complies with Article 30 which is Kansas Administrative Regulation (K.A.R. 28-30-2 thru 28-30-10 as amended 06/07/2013) and statutes in Article 12 which is Kansas Statutes Annotated (K.S.A. 82a-1201 thru 82a-1219 as amended 05/20/2011)

Reconstruction of a water well involving deepening the well or replacing, repairing, adding to, or any modification of the well the casing for the purpose of obtaining groundwater.

An individual who constructs, or treats a water well (including alternations to the well casing to install a pitless adaptor or unit) must be Kansas licensed water well contractor (or the land owner). Such work must comply with regulations in Article 30 (K.A.R. 28-30-2, et seq.).

Well constructed or reconstructed must be reported on a water well record (Form WWC-5). Wells plugged must be reported on a well plugging record (Form WWC-5P). Completed forms must be submitted to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment, Bureau of Water, Geology, & Well Technology Unit.
