## Construction Demolition Material Accepted:

Pallets  
Roofing  
Fencing  
Asphalt  
Sheet Rock  
Tile  
Wood shake shingles  
Windows  
Bricks  
Culverts  
Stumps/ trunks over 24 inches in diameter  
Tree limbs must be cut down to manageable length ( 12 feet)  
Concrete / minimal amount (would like concrete to be separated for the concrete pile)  
Lumber  
Dirt (as long as it is not contaminated and requires a special waste permit)  
Vinyl Siding  
Carpet, padding , tack strip  
Wire  
Foam / Insulation  
Absolutely **NO** trash accepted in C & D (anything that you put into a household trash will not be allowed in C&D)  
*Please note: There will be no charge for clean concrete or clean asphalt loads*

## Municipal Solid Waste (Pit)

Absolutely **NO** Trash is accepted in compost

Tree Limbs  
Stumps/ trunks under 24 inches in diameter  
Absolutely **NO** trash accepted in brush

## Tires

Tires with and with out rims  
up to 23.5 maximum

## Mattress Shed

Mattresses  
box springs

## Household Hazardous Waste

**FROM RESIDENTS ONLY - NO BUSINESS**  
**Approximately 10 gallons per visit**  
**Must be in five gallon container(s) or smaller**
