

Reporting in Person

Offenders who are required to register, are required to register in person, within 3 days, any change in name or use of alias names, any commencement, change or termination of residence location, employment status, or school attendance and any commencement, change or termination in any of the following information:

1. Any anticipated future residence and any temporary lodging information including, but not limited to, address, telephone number and dates of travel for any place in which the offender is staying for 3 or more consecutive days or more than 10 days in any 30 day period.
2. If transient, the locations where the offender has stayed and frequented since last reporting for registration.
3. All telephone numbers at which the offender may be contacted including, but not limited to, all mobile telephone numbers.
4. Height, weight, hair color, scars, and tattoos.
5. Drivers license and all current driver's licenses or identification cards.
6. All vehicle information, including the license plate number, registration number of each license plate assigned to any motor vehicle normally operated by the offender and any other identifier and description of any vehicle owned or operated by the offender, or any vehicle the offender regularly drives, either for personal use or in the course of employment, and information concerning the location or locations such vehicle or vehicles are habitually parked or otherwise kept.
7. License plate number, registration number or other identifier and description of any aircraft or watercraft owned or operated by the offender, and information concerning the location or locations such aircraft or watercraft are habitually parked, docked or otherwise kept.
8. All professional licenses, designations and certifications.
9. Documentation of any treatment received for a mental abnormality or personality disorder of the offender; for purposes of documenting the treatment received.
10. Any and all e-mail addresses and, any and all online identities used by the offender on the internet and any information relating to membership in any online social networks.
11. All travel and immigration documents.
12. Name and telephone number of the offender's probation, parole or community corrections officer.
13. Any stay in a treatment facility, or hospital, private or public, of 3 or more days.
14. Any stay in a correctional facility or jail of 3 or more days.
