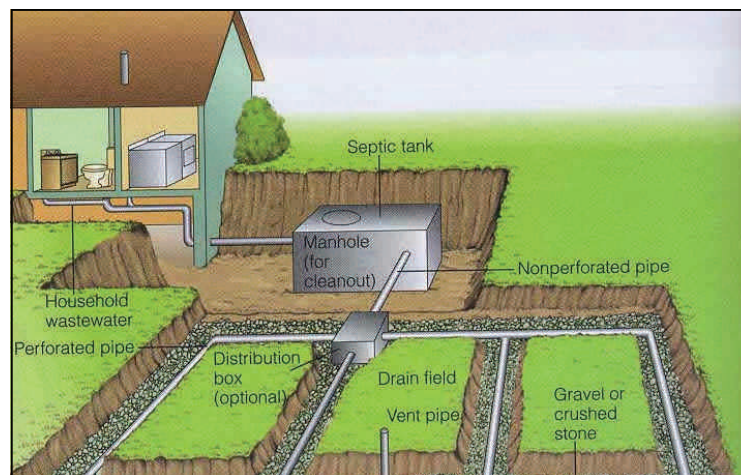


Semi Public Wastewater Systems

- A Semi Public Wastewater System is a system that can generate 1,000 - 2,500 gallons of wastewater per day
- A Semi Public Wastewater System can be a mound, lagoon, conventional system, constructed wetland or an enhanced treatment wastewater system
- Semi Public Systems requires a construction permit, annual operation permit and an annual maintenance inspection by a Licensed Wastewater Contractor
