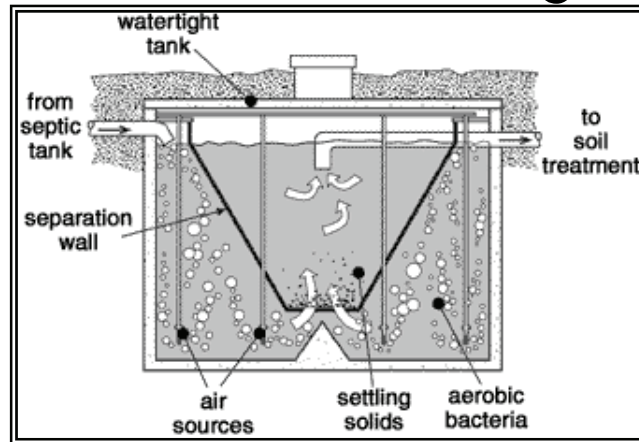


Enhanced Treatment Wastewater Systems



- ✓ New construction on lots created after October 1st, 2003 shall do the following:
 - 1.5 acres & less - public water system and enhanced treatment wastewater system
 - 1.5 acres to 3.0 - enhanced treatment wastewater system
 - 3.0 acres & larger - enhanced treatment wastewater system may be required
- ✓ An Enhanced Treatment System with an Existing Tank must have the Existing Tank pumped and inspected at yearly maintenance.
- ✓ Reconstruction of the wastewater system on existing lots less than 3 acres in unincorporated parts of Reno County.
- ✓ Allows for a special pretreatment process to occur before wastewater is distributed into the laterals.
- ✓ Some treatment units have compressors, filters and alarms to aid in the treatment process.
- ✓ Yearly maintenance inspections are required on all enhanced treatment wastewater systems to ensure proper function.
- ✓ A Licensed Wastewater Contractor or Representative of the Manufacturer of the treatment system shall perform the required maintenance.
- ✓ Always follow the do's and don'ts for your wastewater system.
