- Social & educational support for pregnant women & their infants the 1st year after delivery
- Prenatal Clinics and education
- Home visits by a nurse and social worker
- Healthy Start Home Visitor Program

### Sexual Health Services

- Sexually Transmitted Infection screening for women & men
- Yearly health exam including pap smears
- Pregnancy testing
- Family planning methods (oral contraceptives, injectable contraceptives and long acting reversible contraceptives)
- Counseling and education on women's health issues

### Older Adult Health Services

- Help older adults stay in their homes
  - \* Provide some personal hygiene (bath, hair wash, foot care)
  - \* Provide light housekeeping
  - \* Provide simple meal preparation
  - \* Do some shopping
- Foot Care
  - \* At Health Department & in home
  - \* Offsite facilities throughout the county
- Nurse evaluations for special needs



### Communicable Disease/Prevention Services

- Immunizations
- International travel vaccines
- Tuberculosis screening, treatment, and case management
- Communicable disease surveillance and investigation
- Animal bite investigations
- Well child clinics and school physicals
- Blood lead screening

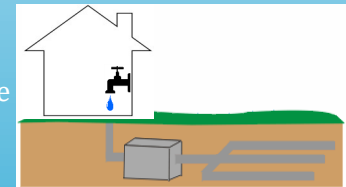
