Construction Demolition Material Accepted:

Pallets
Roofing
Fencing
Asphalt
Sheet Rock
Tile
Wood shake shingles
Windows
Bricks
Culverts
Stumps/ trunks over 24 inches in diameter
Tree limbs must be cut down to manageable length (12 feet)
Concrete / minimal amount (would like concrete to be separated for the concrete pile)
Lumber
Dirt (as long as it is not contaminated and requires a special waste permit)
Vinyl Siding
Carpet, padding , tack strip
Wire
Foam / Insulation
Absolutely **NO** trash accepted in C & D (anything that you put into a household trash will not be allowed in C&D)
Please note: There will be no charge for clean concrete or clean asphalt loads

Municipal Solid Waste (Pit)
